
Introduction

- Joined the SSP in 2013
- Bedroom tax activism and Trident
- Sell shower spares retail, phone orders, internet, Amazon/eBay (spit)
- Use various databases and the internet. Learned semi-modern programming tools.
- Watched the SNP hard at work in Yes Scotland
- Applying all this to our work in RISE.

Scale of the challenge

- 4.1 million registered voters in 2014. (3.9m -2011)
- Transfer to Individual Elector Registration.
- To win a seat, we need 5-8% on a regional list.
- Turnout matters.

Electors



Beware, here be dragons (and a bit of guesswork)

Electors

- Expecting around 3.9million on the electoral roll
- Turnout expected to be high. Around 70%.
- Depending on whether the SNP win a list seat, we need between 5-8% to win a seat.
- "Do The Math!"

Electors – the math

- Approximately 500,000 per region
- 70% turnout → 350,000 votes cast
- 5-8% of these votes 17,500-28,000 votes in a region to win an MSP.
- This is the <u>scale of the task</u>.
- Some of it will happen elsewhere media team, debates and other public engagements.
- We don't have an MSP die cast against us in MSM.
- Most of it will be face to face campaigning.

We need to be ORGANISED

- From TODAY, we have 22 weeks to win these votes.
- Very regular canvassing, leafleting and street stall work.
- Nothing really organised happens in December.
- From the first week of January, we have 17 weeks.
- This is no time at all!

What's needed

- Canvassing remember your efforts during the referendum campaign!
- Survey comfort levels?
- Train people we need every single person.



Canvassing Tech


- SNP use a bespoke system called Activate.
- Records every interaction with voters.
- We can do the same with free and open source software – electoral registers, and open geographical data.
- I've written a system for the Scottish Socialist
 Party, open-sourced it, and am working to get it up
 and running before we hit our campaign stride.
- Cannot re-use SSP canvass data. (sorry.)

COMRADE

- Canvassing and Organisation: Making Regular Activism Downright Easier
- Web tool for making the organisation of a canvass much easier.
- Jargon: Python/Django, a PostGIS database, and Ordnance Survey Open Data - free for anyone to download.
- Help/patches/development welcome

Zoom the map, and pick off the postcodes you'd like to add to this run.



There are 103 addresses on this run so far.


